Actions Arising From Previous Minutes

Shane Fuller provided the Board with an update on all items from the previous minutes, and informed members of the completion of all required actions.

General Business

Shane led the Board through a presentation illustrating the forthcoming Bridgestone Track, with the development anticipated by Salisbury Council to reach 4500 Little Athletics members, as well as thee Athletics clubs within a 20km radius. It was discussed that the opening of such a facility will is unlikely to be detrimental to SA Athletics Stadium bookings, instead creating vacancies for those schools who are currently turned away. The development will also include the construction of a building housing canteen, function facilities and changerooms, with ASA expressing an interest in any future business opportunities. ASA hopes to be able to make use of the Track in the future.

Finance Report

David Cross lead the Board in a lengthy discussion regarding the 2018-19 result, and 2019-20 budget. The Board worked to establish key benchmarks for the new financial year, with business development and fundraising efforts being at the forefront of discussions. The 2019/20 Budget was endorsed by the Board.

CEO's Report

Shane provided the Board with an update on all current grant obligations, with a working group now being established to guide the Back Training Area surface upgrade project. In a further facility update, Shane shared that the majority of equipment for the Outdoor Gym has been installed, with the project now nearing completion. An update on One Sport was also delivered, as well as an update on sponsorship, with connection and renewal negotiations continuing with a number of potential sponsors.
