Actions Arising From Previous Minutes

Shane Fuller provided an update on items from the previous minutes, and informed the Board of the completion of all required actions.

General Business

The Board was joined by Jodie Freund, Industry Advisor for the Office of Recreation Sport and Racing, for their annual Board visit. A number of topics were discussed, including infrastructure plans, grants reviews, and the importance of child safety. The process for a potential Commonwealth Games bid was shared. ASA was also applauded for their commitment to the 40/20/20 gender diversity initiative, and acknowledged the importance of continuing to implement the initiative further within the organisation and its subcommittees.
